

## **Questions you may have about coming back to Church.**

We are so excited to worship together again but we also want to take every precaution in providing a safe worship environment for you and your family that follows the state and local CDC guidelines.

Here are the answers to a few of the questions that you may have.

\*Please note that these plans are fluid and are subject to further development, and additional guidelines provided by our governing authorities.

### **How will the services work?**

- We will continue to provide our online streaming platform for those who may not be able to attend in person, or who are uncomfortable with attending in person. The online service will be at 11:00am.
- Each service will last approximately 45 minutes. This will allow us time to clean the venue and help accommodate families with children.
- We will offer three service options with limited seating so that we can maintain social distancing. Initially, Pastor Dennis will speak in all three services.

-9:30am/ Classic (Sanctuary)

-10:15am/ B3 Auditorium (Contemporary)

-11:00am/ Sanctuary (Contemporary)

### **How do I sign up?**

- Participant Limitation: Each service will be limited to enable social distancing. Everyone must pre-register at our online sign up. This can be found on our website, and Facebook page. We will insist on not exceeding the stipulated capacity. This limit is to allow for social distancing guidelines to be met, and appropriate measures accomplished as people are entering & exiting the venue.
- Service Registration: Everyone (that is, family units or single) will be required to preregister for the service they would like to attend. Registrants will receive a confirmation email. Upon arrival at your designated entrance, there will be a host to check you in and then you can proceed to whichever venue you are attending. Ushers will be available if you need help finding a seat.
- Parking: Since we will have different services happening in different parts of our building, we will designate certain parking lots that correspond to that venue to ensure we abide by social distancing guidelines. Each venue/service will have separate entrances and exits so that we can maximize physical distancing.
- Seating: All seating in the services will follow the distancing guidelines. Special exceptions will be given to families who wish to sit closer together.
- Guests: There will be an allowance in our registration process to allow room for guests who are not registered.

**Other questions:**

- Masks and temperature checks: All staff and volunteers will be wearing masks. Staff and volunteers will also have their temperature checked. We do encourage that those who attend also wear a mask but will not require it.
- Sanitizing: We will sanitize the worship spaces and bathrooms in between each service with professional sanitizing equipment generously provided by a church member. We will also have sanitizing stations available at every entrance.
- Offering: We will not pass the offering plate. For the foreseeable future, you can give online, mail your offering, or drop it in a plate as you leave. Those plates will be supervised.
- Bulletins: If you desire to have a bulletin please print the ebulletin at home and bring it with you.

**What about Sunday School and Small groups?**

At this time, we will not be having Sunday School or small groups on campus.

**Will there be childcare?**

- We will not be offering childcare, or in person kid church until further notice. As much as we look forward to getting those ministries restarted, we feel that it would be too difficult to maintain social distancing and provide a safe environment in our Kid's Department.
- We do love your children and encourage those who feel comfortable to bring your kids to our corporate services.
- We will be shortening each service to provide a family friendly time frame, and we will also incorporate a kid church element into our services so there will be a familiar feeling for them.
- We also recommend that you download the ebulletin coloring sheet and bring it with crayons or markers so your children can color it during the service.
- The service will also be on the TVs in the common areas of the church should you desire to watch part or all the service with your child in one of those areas.
- We will also be continuing Kid Church Live for those who are not comfortable bringing their children yet.
