DEVOTION FROM OUR SUMMER INTERNS

1 Thessalonians 5:11 "Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing."

I have heard a Christian professor say that humans are body-soul-relational creatures. A body is our physical form, a soul is the part of us that will live eternally, and our relationships are how we stand with God and with those around us. It is God who crafted our bodies and our souls, and he who put us in relationship with himself and those around us. But all three, our bodies, our souls, and our relationships were affected by the fall. Now our bones ache and our bodies break, now our souls are separated from God without Christ, and now our relationships are broken.

Humans are made for relationships. We were made to be in a perfect relationship with God and with each other. Adam and Eve walked together with God in the garden (Gen. 3:8). But when they fell, and when we endorse their sin with sin of our own, we experience the effects of broken relationships. A part of our humaneness is distorted. Just as we fight against the decay of the body, and we seek to be in right standing with God, we must honor God by pursuing right relationships.

When Jesus was ministering on Earth how did he spend most of his time? Who was it that followed him around everywhere he went? His disciples. Jesus knew the importance of the body, he healed the sick and the blind and the deaf. He knew the eternal importance of the soul; He proclaimed the good news of salvation. And He knew the importance of investing in relationships with those twelve men. That is simply a reminder to me that relationships really, really matter!

Yes our relationships are broken. But yes they can be restored and grown in Christ. Whatever kind of broken relationships you are facing can be restored and mended. Whoever in your family or friends needs a strong connection or relationship with you right now I encourage you seek to pour into them; those whom God has placed in front of you today.
