## **Blood Assurance CCP**

## **FAQs**

- 1. What is Convalescent Plasma? COVID-19 convalescent plasma is a treatment where plasma is transfused from a recovered COVID-19 donor into a critically ill patient. This is an investigational treatment by the FDA as a therapy for critically ill coronavirus patients.
- **2.** How long does it take to donate plasma? Plasma donation takes about 45 minutes to an hour.
- 3. How should I prepare for my donation?
  - Eat a well-balanced, high protein, low fat meal within 3-4 hours of your donation.
  - Increase your fluid intake in the 24 hours leading up to your appointment.
- 4. Can I speed up this process?
  - a. If you are hydrate well, the procedure might go more smoothly. The length of time on the machine is determined by many factors such as height, weight, hemoglobin, and condition of vein.
  - b. You may download the "Quickscreen" App at <a href="www.bloodassurance.org/quickscreen">www.bloodassurance.org/quickscreen</a> and complete your interview health questions on the DAY OF your donation to save time. Once completed, you will be given a barcode that you may present at donation for the staff member to scan and assess your answers.
- **5.** How often can I donate CCP? Blood Assurance allows CCP donation on a special schedule of weekly x 4, then twice a week for one month, then on a Q28 day schedule. They will attempt to make this as convenient as possible and if you are not able to donate on this schedule your plasma is still needed as often as you are able.
- 6. Can I donate if I have received plasma while ill with COVID-19?

  Yes! But, this has not always been the case. There is a waiting period after receiving convalescent plasma before you may donate plasma. This will be discussed at your prescreen call with Blood Assurance staff. Please inform the staff at that time.
- **7. Does Blood Assurance do antibody tests on my plasma?** Yes, but the results will not be given over the phone. If positive, you will continue to be called to schedule donations. If negative, you will be notified that your plasma is no longer requested. There is also a sample kept from each donation to be sent to the Mayo Clinic as requested.
- 8. Why is an antibody test not performed before I donate, if I had a positive nasal swab? Per FDA, it is not required and it is assumed that the antibodies will be present in the plasma from someone who has recovered from the virus. Testing will be done at each plasma donation to confirm presence.

9. I've gotten the antibody test performed by Blood Assurance, when will I get my results?

If this was from a whole blood donation, please refer to the consent that you signed prior to the sample for testing which states that you will only be notified if BOTH tests are positive. If you do not receive notification, please assume that the test was negative.

- **10.Is this really helping patients?** There is much anecdotal evidence to show that CCP helps most patients. Of course there needs to be further research to confirm. Each donation can provide up to 4 patient doses of plasma.
- **11.Can I have my friends and family donate as well?** They might potentially qualify to donate CCP if they were exposed to you via close personal contact. Contact Blood Assurance for more details.
- **12.How can someone qualify if they were not tested by your facility?** They may submit a form to <a href="www.bloodassurance.org/covidplasma">www.bloodassurance.org/covidplasma</a> for more details and to get started on the process to qualify.
- **13.Can someone get qualified if they never had a positive nasal swab test?** It is possible. Blood Assurance would need to arrange for them to have special antibody testing done to qualify them using a double-test method. Both tests must be positive to qualify.
