### **DEVOTION FROM OUR SUMMER INTERNS**

Prudency is a characteristic of humanity that is viewed as part of the providence of God. We are constantly seeing future events unfold, but we do know the future, only anticipate its events. I know sometimes this unknowingness of the future is uneasy. For instance, every time I watch my football team play an intense game, I always wish I knew the outcome to break the eagerness of the end result. Another was when I auditioned for All-state band and choir. I did not know if I was to make it, and it induced a worrisome attitude. Have you ever thought about why being prudent is a quality of humankind? God is the maker of everything, and He is responsible for the attributes of his people. Therefore, there must be a significant reason why prudency is a characteristic, given that God placed it in us. God's providence, God's protective care, is guiding humanity through the course of their life, but many people debate human involvement. Prudence is part of God's providence in our life, as highlighted in the wisdom tradition, so we need to value due prudence.

Proverbs describe the wise as having prudence and a fountain of life, but folly will punish the foolish. Have you ever done something in your life that is based on impulse? Maybe it was a shopping spree, talking back to a parent or a spouse, cutting someone off on the road, or divulging personal information to untrustworthy people. Did these decisions in your life come out of a prudent nature? If God uses our prudence as His providence, we should take great care in our choices. Discernment of situations and anticipating outcomes are qualities of people that have wisdom. God gives us the free will to be able to choose what to do, but the providence of God is still in the works of our hearts. So, we should listen to the cautious nature of our being. Do not be foolish in your actions for folly will bring punishment. Instead, be wise and careful in the deliberation of events in your life. John Calvin, a theologian during the reformation, states, "people's hearts will make their path, but God directs their steps." We as Christians must be sensitive to the will of the Lord and seek His way. Through prudence, which is given to us by God, and trusting the nature of God's creation, we will walk in the way of the wise.
