Chair Fundraiser

As most of you are aware we are remodeling our auditorium. We knew going into the project that prices could increase, and supply issues could arise. We mentioned in our original town hall meeting that if that occurred, we would ask folks to consider donating to purchase chairs. We have worked extremely hard to keep expenses down and have kept many items under budget, but wood and the price of chairs have increased significantly. We do not want to compromise on the quality and comfort of chairs so we are asking if you would consider donating toward the purchase of chairs. If each family donated enough to cover the number of chairs that their family requires it would significantly offset this budget item.

The price of each chair is \$115. A couple could donate \$230. A family of four - \$460. Some of you might want to purchase an entire row at \$920. Others may be able to give more and others less. Any amount will make a difference. We ask that you pray and if God leads you to give above your regular offering, designate your check for chairs or mark it electronically if you do online giving.
