Musings from a Pastor's Bicycle Ride

Burning Bush Family,

We are quickly approaching seven months of pandemic life. It has been strange and weird. I do not know of anyone that would say they like it. We have all learned from it, but I know we are all ready to move on from it.

Seven months is a long time to be away from church. I wanted to take a moment to make a few suggestions regarding our online service.

- 1. Keep your Sunday morning routine the same. Perhaps you are starting to feel disconnected with God and the church. It is easy to do when you have not made Sunday morning worship a priority. Sure, you can "play" the service anytime you want. You can "do" church Sunday afternoon or right before bed on Tuesday night or whenever. But we all know what happens when you get out of the routine of Sunday morning. Your day fills up and before you know it, it is Wednesday, and you still haven't had a chance to worship. By keeping your Sunday morning routine you assure yourself that you will spend time in worship and in hearing God's Word preached as well as making the transition back to in-person church easier when that time comes for you and your family.
- 2. Participate do not just "watch." I am afraid a lot of folks are watching our services like they would any other TV show or video. I encourage you not to just watch but engage and participate. I understand that some of you may feel silly singing out loud but even if you are not comfortable singing make sure you are fully engaged with the at-home service.
- 3. Make it a priority. When you are sitting there in your comfy clothes in your living room it is easy to get distracted. If you are preparing lunch, having text conversations or wrestling around with your dog while the service is playing chances are pretty good for most of you that God is not really going to be able to speak to you through the clutter and distractions. Be sure you set aside that time free of distractions so that God can truly minister, encourage and teach you.

We miss those of you who have not been able to return, but there is no judgment and we look forward to when you can return. In the meantime, grow in your faith and thank goodness we are blessed to have the technology to have online services.
